

Contributor's agreement

The PCR mission is to serve the needs of each individual patient by helping the cardiovascular community share knowledge, experience and practice.

By participating to a PCR Event, the Contributor agrees to the following:

Commitments

PCR commits to providing advice and guidance to enhance the educational quality and teaching value of PCR Events, based on the inputs of the cardiovascular interventional community.

In return, by accepting to contribute to a PCR Event, the Contributor commits to:

- adhering to the fundamental principles of the educative value of a PCR Event
- adhering to the preparation process that has been developed by a group of experienced physician coordinators according to PCR's educational objectives and mission.
- selecting the treatment that best suits the identified patient's needs, without bearing any inappropriate influence from Industry partners in the selection of the technologies/devices.
- working in accordance with the fundamental principles of a patient-centred approach to post-graduate continuous medical education, putting the focus on educational quality and teaching capabilities towards a well-defined targeted audience.
- declaring their potential conflicts of interest on their Guest Website.
- accepting that their session(s) and their performance may be evaluated by participants, peers, and PCR board members to participate in the continuous improvement of the educational quality of the PCR courses. Individual assessment results will stay confidential and will only be shared with the people in charge of building and delivery of the session(s) in which they are taking part.

Compliance and liability

The Contributor guarantees that the content of his/her Contribution is compliant with the law and does not breach any rights of third parties (such as copyrights, images, obligation of confidentiality notably), either because he/she is the owner of the rights on all the components included in his/her Contribution, or because these components are free of any rights, or because he/she has obtained the express authorisation of the relevant third parties.

The Contributor undertakes to ensure with the utmost care the accuracy of the information he/she provides.

The Contributor alone shall be the liable for the content of his/her Contribution and undertakes to guarantee Europa should the liability of Europa come to be incurred by a third party because of the content of the Contribution.

When including pictures in their presentation, the Contributor is aware that he/she shall be solely responsible for verifying if the images are copyright-free. He/she should be cautious when sourcing

images from the internet, as they are generally not free of copyright and could expose the Contributor to financial penalties (€1,500 per image) from their respective authors.

Publications of your contribution

The contribution, as well as all the accessories thereof (such as: illustrations, text of the presentation, presentation materials, accompanying documents, etc.) and all media (such as paper, IT file, photo, audio, video, Recording, Webcast presentations, slides ...) are hereafter referred to collectively as the "Contribution".

For educational purposes in PCR activities, the Contributor will be asked to accept or refuse a number of authorisations of reproduction related to each of his/her Contributions on the Guest website. In case of co-authorship, the contributor is solely responsible for getting the co-authors' consent on the given authorisations of reproduction.

The right to use the Contribution within the meaning hereof shall mean the right for Europa to freely reproduce and use the Contribution, which includes the right to use it fully, as well as in the form of extracts, to incorporate it into larger sets, next to other contributions, to translate it, to illustrate it with photographs / images of its choice, subject to complying with the following obligations:

- Europa undertakes to always refer to the quality of the Contributor,
- Europa undertakes not to amend the content of the Contribution without the consent of the Contributor (Europa being however entitled to freely make extracts / translations)
- Europa undertakes to offer the Contributor the possibility to amend the content of his/her presentation at any time, including if certain information proves to be inaccurate or obsolete.
- Europa undertakes to ensure the respect for the reputation of the Contributor and to communicate his/her Contribution in conditions likely to benefit thereto.

The Contributor recognises that, as a result of the communication of the Contribution by Europa, said Contribution may be referenced by various search engines/websites and journals partners of Europa, which the Contributor expressly accepts.

Fees and honorarium

In particular:
